Introduction

This document contains release notes for op5 Monitor 3.0. The document is intended to give brief information about the new release. It is directed towards staff responsible for managing op5 products.

What's New

LDAP authentication

You can now let op5 Monitor authenticate against an LDAP server of your choice. The system includes OpenLDAP as user backend but you can also authenticate against a Microsoft Active Directory or an external openldap server.

Profiles and cloning

It is now easier to do mass configuration, since we have done many changes with larger installations in mind. You can define profiles for different types of hosts, for example database server and webserver. The profiles can include host information, associated services, and other types of related objects as well. You simply use the profile when defining new hosts and get all configurations from the profile with a very small effort.

PHP API

To integrate with external systems, for example CMDB:s, management tools we now provide a PHP API that can be used to automate the configuration of op5 Monitor. Using the API you can add or delete hosts and modify other kinds of objects as well. Contact op5 support for more information about the API.

Test your configuration

To simplify creation of new services and checkcommands you can now test your configuration directly in the configure tool and get an instant response in your web browser without having to save the configuration. This comes in handy when you are configuring a new checkcommand or a new service.

New look and feel

The web GUI has been updated with a new look and feel. Much work has been put into the Configure tool that now includes:

- New layout
- Integrated help texts
- Instant configuration validation
- Easier to understand error messages

Installation and Upgrade Notes

op5 Monitor 3.2 can be installed on all existing op5 platforms; Entry, Standard and Large. op5 Monitor 3.0 is required for upgrading.
