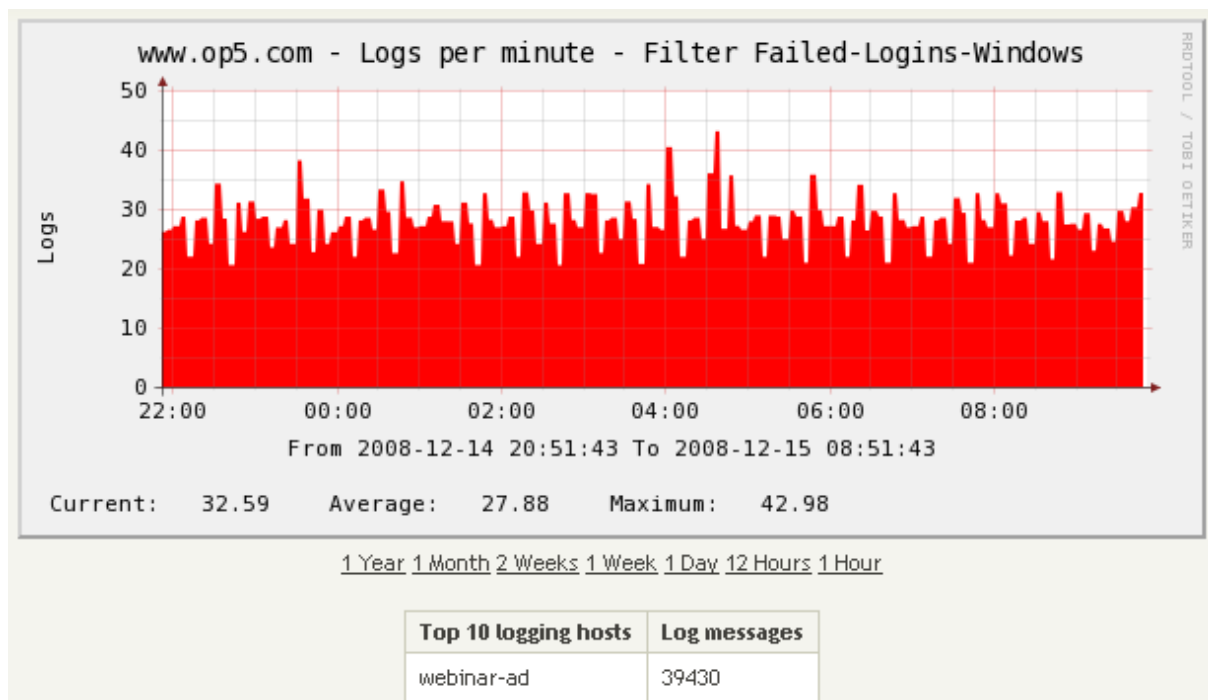
Introduction

This document contains release notes for op5 Logserver 3.3. The document is intended to give brief information about the new release. It is directed towards staff responsible for managing op5 Logserver.

What's New

Summary reports

The summary reports gives you a graphical presentation of the amount of log messages that are received. You create the reports based on your filters and as soon as you created the report, data is gathered and presented for you.





Bidirectional editing of filters between search box and query builder

Now the search box and query builder works as expected and let you edit your query using either the query builder or the query language directly in the search box.

Hierarchical filters

We take the search one step forward by allowing nested filter searches. For example: Define a filter matching the ip segments for your network equipment, then define a filter matching messages about malformed packets. Combining these filters you get a match on messages about malformed packets from your network equipment.

Configurable default filter per user

This lets the administrator select a default filter for a user.

Installation and Upgrade Notes

At least op5 Logserver 3.0 is required for upgrading. Upgrade is possible either by using yum or by using the downloadable .tar.gz file
